BAKANO is a design and sewing workshop where we produce bags and accessories from upcycled leather. In our workshop, old sofas and worn leather jackets reappear as uniquely sustainable designs.





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We are in the process of up scaling our current business and establishing the workshop as a starting point for green job creation for vulnerable unemployed people in collaboration with Holbæk Municipality and other relevant stakeholders.

The project rethinks human and material waste of resources and rests on four pillars:

SOCIAL: We want to create green jobs for vulnerable unemployed

ENVIRONMENT: We want to contribute to the circular economy by increasing the recycling rate of leather and textiles and conveying sustainability in fashion and textile production.

DESIGN: With timeless and classic design that lasts both in quality and across fashion phenomena, we want to inspire not only in Denmark but throughout the Nordic region for sustainable consumption in fashion and textiles.

GROWTH: Economic growth is a condition for being able to create the green jobs for vulnerable unemployed. We believe that everyone has something to contribute, and we want to be at the forefront of a process in which companies with social and environmental responsibility become a natural and competitive part of the market and the economy. We insist that socio-economic enterprises can create real growth.

We will work strategically with the UN's Global Goals for Sustainable Development.
